
#### Horizon Europe\_\_\_\_



Horizon Europe is the EU's key funding programme for research and innovation. With a <u>budget of €95.5</u> <u>billion</u>, it is the most ambitious publicly funded R&I programme in the world.

The programme facilitates collaboration and strengthens the impact of research and innovation in developing, supporting and implementing EU policies while tackling global challenges.

It is structured in 3 pillars and one additional component to support activities in Widening Participation and Strengthening the European Research Area (ERA).



#### **Horizon Europe Structure and Eligibility**



The European Innovation Council (EIC) aims to support top-class innovators, entrepreneurs, small companies and researchers with bright ideas and ambitions to scale-up internationally. The EIC by supporting high-risk, high-impact ideas, will turn science into new business.

Missions are commitments to solve some of the greatest challenges facing our world. Each mission will operate as a portfolio of actions – such as research projects, policy measures or even legislative initiatives - to achieve a measurable goal that could not be achieved through individual actions.



#### **Eligibility**

- EU Member States
- Third Countries associated: Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Georgia, Iceland, Israel, Kosovo\*, Moldova, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey Other third countries:
- <u>List</u> of low- to middle-income countries automatically eligible for funding
- Other countries that are neither EU Member States nor countries associated to Horizon Europe, nor countries listed above, are not automatically eligible for funding and therefore usually have to participate at their own cost.

Joint, aligned and flexible actions to tackle adequately global challenges through industrial competitiveness, to achieve a sustainable and inclusive growth.

## **Cluster 2:** Culture Creativity & Inclusive Society

This cluster aims to address EU priorities that:

- Give a new push to European democracy, enhancing participation, pluralism, nondiscrimination;
- Protect cultural heritage, fostering a creative economy as well as sustainable and inclusive business models;
- Better manage migration and mobility, enhancing integration;

#### **Erasmus+**



#### **General Objective:**

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support educational, professional and personal development of people of all ages in education, training, youth and sport in Europe and beyond.

It has an estimated budget of €26.2 billion. This is nearly double the funding compared to its predecessor programme (2014-2020).

The 2021-2027 **horizontal priorities** strongly focus on **social inclusion**, **green** and **digital transitions**.

It supports priorities and activities set out in the European Education Area, Digital Education Action Plan and the European Skills Agenda.

#### **Creative Europe**



Its budget is made of €1.842 billion in current prices as part of the new MFF (2021-2027) and an additional top-up of € 0,6 billion in 2018 prices.

Programme's general objectives are:

To safeguard, develop and promote European cultural and linguistic diversity and heritage. To increase the competitiveness and the economic potential of the cultural and creative sectors, in particular the audiovisual sector.

The Creative Europe programme is structured into three strands:

**CULTURE strand** to enhance and cultural artistic cooperation at the European level and strengthen the economic and social dimension of the cultural European and creative sector

**CROSS-SECTORAL** strand support policy to cooperation and actions spanning the across audiovisual other and cultural and creative sectors

MEDIA strand to support and promote the competitiveness of the European audiovisual industry, including through mobility in the European audiovisual sector

#### **Cross Border Cooperation**



The Cross Border Cooperation (CBC) is a crucial element of the EU policy towards its neighbours.

It promotes **cooperation between EU countries and neighbouring countries** by reducing the differences in living standards and addressing common challenges across borders.

#### 3 main goals:

- promoting economic and social development in border areas
- addressing common challenges
- putting in place better conditions for persons, goods and capital mobility

The CBC budget comes from two different sources: the European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI) and the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF).

#### **Cross Border Cooperation**



The Cross Border Cooperation is encompassed within the INTERREG Programme. INTERREG has 5 different programmes, 3 of which are dedicated to cross border cooperation with and among non EU members.

- 1. Interreg A Cross Border Cooperation, implemented within the EU and at EU's external borders
- 2. Interreg B Transnational Cooperation, involves regions from several countries of the EU forming bigger areas
- **3. Interreg C Interregional Cooperation**, 4 different programmes for EU Member States: Interreg Europe, Interact, Urbact and Espon
- 4. The Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance Cross Border Cooperation (IPA CBC): supports cross-border co-operation between candidate countries, potential candidate countries and EU Member States
- **5. European Neighbourhood Instrument Cross Border Cooperation (ENI CBC)**: a total 15 programmes cover 12 land borders, stretching from Finland and Russia in the north, to countries like Hungary and Ukraine in the east, and Italy, Northern Africa and the Middle East in the south.

**Interreg Transnational Cooperation**, **IPA CBC** and **ENI CBC** offer funding possibilities for non-EU countries.



#### **Human Rights and Democracy Programme**

It is the flagship **European programme on human rights and democracy**, built upon the key features of the European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights (**EIDHR**). EIDHR was created by the European Parliament in 1994 to support both the activities of civil society working for human rights and democracy and the efforts of international organisations.

#### 5 overarching **priorities**:

- 1. Protecting and empowering individuals;
- 2. Building resilient, inclusive and democratic societies;
- 3. Promoting a global system for human rights and democracy;
- 4. Harnessing the opportunities and addressing challenges of new technologies;
- 5. Delivering by working together.

#### **Thematic multi-annual indicative Programmes**



#### **Civil Society Organizations**

The programme is funded through the Global Europe: Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI), with the specific aim of strengthening CSOs as independent actors of good governance and development in their own right.

#### **Priorities:**

- an inclusive, participatory, empowered, and independent civil society
- A better-informed and more inclusive society with a developed sense of co-responsibility for sustainable development,

#### **Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA III)**



IPA III is a part of the heading 6: **NEIGHBOURHOOD AND THE WORLD**.

Pre-accession assistance supports EU **candidate countries** and **potential candidates** in adopting and implementing key political, institutional, social and economic reforms to comply with EU values and to progressively align with its rules, standards and policies.

Project name: WE ACT - Women Empowerment and ACTion in politics and media

Funding program: thematic program on human rights and Democracy - Turkey

Overall goal: Improve the exercise of political and civic rights for women and LGBTIQ+ persons at the local level

#### Specific objectives:

- Increase the political participation of women in the upcoming local elections of Turkey (2024) in the 7 regions of Turkey
- Improve conditions for a democratic debate on gender issues at the local policy level making progress in all regions of Turkey

#### **Target groups:**

150 women, aspiring candidates for the local elections; 40 - 50 CSOs striving for women and LGBTIQ+ rights

**Duration:** 30 months (02.01.2023 - 30.06.2025)

#### Activities:

WP1: Political empowerment of women (electoral cycle, leadership, electoral campaign organisation, etc.)

WP2: Capacity building on participatory democracy, for candidates and CSOs representing women and LGBTIQ+

WP3: empowerment of women on media (how to use media, how to release interviews, run a podcast, etc.)




